Seasonal shots!

Everyone worries about flu and pneumonia at this time of year. You don't need to! We can help you stay fit for Christmas (the countdown has started...) and your winter holidays. Beat the queue (and the flu!) with vaccinations starting in late September.

If you are pregnant, make sure you receive your flu vaccine as soon as possible. Pneumonia vaccination is available all year round but just let us know if you'd like to have it when you come along for your flu jab. Remember that the pneumonia vaccine is a one shot dose for life, but you'll need to top up the flu vaccine every year.

Your little ones don't need to worry about a needle - we offer a flu nose spray from the age of 2 and we can protect babies from 6 months with an injection too.

The NHS has traditionally offered the pneumonia vaccination to those aged 70 but we are pleased to provide this service to everybody on request - even children. If you suffer with ongoing chest, heart or diabetic problems, it's really important to have this vaccine.

Every winter our flu clinics are extremely popular so we will again be running clinics on some Saturdays and Sundays throughout October - ring and reserve will be in operation due to limited stocks of the vaccines. We can of course administer the vaccines during a routine appointment so please let us know if you'd like to take advantage of this.

Attention all University students!

Please book in for your ACWY meningitis vaccine ASAP. The Department of Health is recommending vaccination because Meningitis W is becoming more common. The ACWY vaccine protects against four different causes of meningitis and septicaemia - meningococcal (Men) A, C, W and Y diseases. Students in their first year at university are nearly FOUR times more likely to catch meningococcal disease than the general public so please don't take any chances.

Did you know we offer BCG vaccination to protect against tuberculosis (TB)?



The vaccine is suitable from birth. Anybody over the age of six will require a Mantoux test prior to BCG vaccination - this test checks for prior exposure to TB.

It is a tiny injection into the forearm - you'll come back to see us 2 to 3 days later to have the test interpreted and we can carry out the BCG vaccination at that time if need be.

Do I need it?

If you are moving overseas to a high risk country (Africa, Asia, South America, Russia and China in particular) or your family are from an area where TB is prevalent then the Department of Health recommends having the BCG vaccination.

If you fit into any of the categories below, then you should also consider being vaccinated for added protection:

Those considering working in a medical setting, eg, work experience students in a UK hospital or overseas.

Also doctors, nurses, vets and laboratory staff and those returning to these professions after a career break.

Be aware that BCG vaccination may be a requirement for a work/travel visa.
